



Welcome to the Cape Cod Challenge Cup

CCCT APP: Please download our **"FREE" tournament app** on your Smartphone (iPhone or Android) for all the latest tournament information, schedule, and scores. This app will be a vital part of communication with you and your team during the tournament. Please encourage all of your parents to download it to help you with coordinating your players and their families.

SCHEDULES: Please check your schedules at registration to make sure that your games have not changed from the original schedule. **Field or time changes** may be made throughout the weekend. All changes will be posted on line, at the registration tent and on our ***FREE tournament app***. If you have not already done so, **please leave all cell phone contact numbers at the registration tent. Go to our website www.capecodchallengecup.net for info.**

SCORES: We update scores as quickly as we can. **Please inform your parents that they may go to Got Soccer and register their cell phone #s for text updates on scores and standings.**

ZERO TOLERANCE POLICY. We enforce a Zero Tolerance Policy. There are field marshals on each field to monitor the sportsmanship of the spectators and coaches. All parents will sign the form to be passed in at registration.

MEDICAL FIRST AID KITS: Are located at each site. Please contact a field marshal if routine medical care is needed by trainers who are on duty for the tournament. For emergency, **call 911.**

NO DOGS/ALCOHOL/TOBACCO PRODUCTS OF ANY KIND is allowed on the fields at any time.

TRAFFIC REMINDER: It is Memorial Day Weekend on Cape Cod. If your soccer schedule allows, it is best to leave early in the morning Monday (prior to 8AM) or later in the evening (after 7PM). **Go to Traffic reports on our app.**



Coaches Tournament registration Check-In List (to be passed in at Registration)

 2 copies of team roster (CCCCT will keep one) that have been signed by your club registrar, your state or league registrar. Please cross off any player that will **not** be playing and please add “guest players” to the tournament roster, both copies. ****MUST INCLUDE PLAYER JERSEY #S ON ROSTER.**

 Photo Player Pass cards **(OR) COPIES of birth certificates** and **PHOTO ID for each player**. This is mandatory. If pass cards are **not** available, passport, or school photo may be used with birth certificate as proof of identity. Any player found to be playing in the wrong age group will result in the club, the coach, and the player being reported to their state youth soccer association. Referees **will** check rosters during the tournament.

must be signed by all parents prior to first game.

 Coaches are required to provide all cell phone #s for coaching staff (asst. coach, team manager) , hotel phone number (if applicable) at time of registration.

 READ and provide tournament rules to entire coaching staff prior to tournament.

 Remind your parents: **A ZERO TOLERANCE POLICY** is in effect for the entire tournament. *All parents will need to sign the form to be turned in with the team registration packet. Those parents and or any spectators in violation will risk being removed from the tournament.*

Zero Tolerance Policy for the Cape Cod Challenge Cup

All persons responsible for a team **and the** spectators for that team shall support the referee. Failure to do so will undermine the referee's authority and has the potential of creating a hostile environment for players, the referee, and all other participants and spectators. **Spectators *(as defined below) is not to address the referees or any player during the game unless as outlined below.**

***Spectators: (PARENTS/VISITORS/SIBLINGS)**

During the game:

May respond to a referee's initiation of communication. May point out emergencies or safety issues. May respond to players with encouragement

Penalties:

- 1st infraction - Referee will stop the game and ask **the coach** to quiet the offending spectator.
- 2nd infraction - Verbal warning. Referee will stop the game and ask the coach to warn the spectator that the next infraction will be an ejection or the referee will abandon the game.
- 3rd infraction - Referee shall instruct the coach to direct the spectator to leave the field. Referee will abandon the game if the spectator refuses to leave the field.

If the referee abandons the game, the referee shall file a report and notify the Cape Cod Challenge Cup Referee Coordinator.
